#### Postmaster General retires from service

Mr. Winston Brown, has retired from the post of Postmaster General after nearly 39 years in the postal service, the last five of which was spent as its head.

Mr. Brown, 59 went on pre-retirement leave on November 6 last, year. His retirement became official on January 30 this year.

Mr R. I Knight, former Assistant Post Master General has taken over as Acting Post Master General.

Mr. Brown entered the Postal Service in 1934 as an Assistant (Clerk), and was appointed to the head post in 1967, after being appointed Deputy Post Master General in 1964 and Acting Post Master General in early 1967.

Mr. Brown said he will still be active as The Executive Secretary of the Heads a Government Departments Conference. He also explained that his services would always be available to the Ministry of Communications whenever necessary.

Mr G. I. Dundas remains Deputy Post Master General, while Mr L Jackson is now the Acting Assistant Post Master General (Postal), the position formerly, held by Mr Knight.
