POLICY

When Mr. Herbert MacDonald, O.B.E. obtained permission for the printing of the Miniature sheet.; he felt that at least a portion of these sheets would be donated or given to the fund for the National Sports Ltd. However, with the change in Government this was not done, but instead National Sports Ltd. paid for the Miniature Sheets - the full face value - plus any extras incurred in printing, etc. which made the sales of these Miniature Sheets a pretty poor showing. But it is interesting to see that when the Issue now on sale throughout the West Indies - "Freedom from Hunger" - Jamaica as well as the other countries have donated a large portion towards this wonderful Organization. The same thing will take place later in the year when the British Red Cross issue their Commemorative Set.

If this can be done for this Issue, why wasn't it done for National Sports Ltd? The simple answer to this is that up to the present there is no direct policy in the General Post Office. The sooner that they can get down and arrange their Philatelic Agency in Jamaica, and distribute all their stamps whether they have stocks from 1960 or before makes no difference.

No stamps should ever be demonetized and it is interesting to see that Jamaica's Issue of the "Freedom from Hunger" there is no watermark on these sheets, as Jamaica has selected its own watermark on their New Issue.

Unfortunately all the previous Issues of Jamaican stamps have already been demonetized, but all Issues since August last year should always be on sale, unless sold out - but never demonetized.

It is interesting to see England getting more Philatelic minded than ever, as they are issuing five Commemorative Issues during the year, plus special postmarking for the First Day Covers on Meter. Perhaps this might be installed into Jamaica before long, and one looks forward to the day when Jamaica will have its own Agency and distributes their own stamps plus special postmarking on First Day Covers.

NEWS HERE AND THERE

JAMAICA

New Jamaica Postage Rates from July 1st will be as follows:

- Inland letters from 2d. to 3d, with 1½d. extra for each oz. instead of 1d.
- Newspaper wrappers and post cards will be 1½d. instead of 1d.
- While Registration will be up to 6d. per letter instead of 4d.
- Parcel Post Inland will be 4d. per lb. instead of 3d. while each additional lb. will be 4d.
- Letter Boxes which have been 12/- per year for the past fifty years will now be £2.
- Likewise Air Mail will go up to 1/- for North and South America from 8d. This also applies to the Bahamas.
- Air Letter Sheets remain the same - 6d.

JAMAICA Temporary Rubber Date mark collectors will be interested in knowing that there are now six routes e.g. TPO - 6 for the Travelling Post Office.

JAMAICA With the change in Postage Rates - Jamaica's New Issue will not be ready for another five months, as several changes will have to be made in bringing in new values.

JAMAICA An extremely fine error on the 2d. Independence stamp can be found with double Overprint. A full cover was shown to us by Dr. Dennis Adams, of the University of the West Indies, and feel sure that there must be several other copies around.

BAHAMAS POST OFFICES LIST

Regarding the above-mentioned list in the last Issue, G.J. Raymond writes that the following amendments should be made:

WALKERS CAY under Abaco should be deleted and added under "P.O's Now Closed." In the latter category, WILSON CITY should be marked out, as that P.O. existed solely under the name "SPENCER'S POINT" only; and one closed P.O. should be correctly spelled NORMAN'S CASTLE. Under HARBOUR ISLAND, an asterisk (*) should be placed alongside Dunmore Town, as only the name of the island appears in the postmark.

NEWS ITEM

BRITISH HONDURAS: A new sub P.O. opened 1st March, 1963 at "20 MILES" in the Stann Creek Valley. This replaced a previous one named "18¼ MILES, SIC VALLEY, which had replaced a previous one named "STANN CREEK VALLEY (22 :Miles):" The new P.O., according to G.J. Raymond, has only a seal - type cancel inscribed "20 MILES" at top, and "STANK CREEK B.H." below, plus a registry rubberstamp similarly inscribed. A standard date stamp' has been on order and should be on hand by the time this note appears.
