

Jamaica Post Office Act of 1867

JAMAICA.N0.15 of 1867.
ASSENTED TO BY THE GOVERNOR
29TH MARCH, 1867.

A Law to Continue in Force, for a Limited Period,
the Act to Provide for the Management of the Post-Office.

WHEREAS the act of the twenty-sixth Victoria, session one, chapter seven, entitled An act to provide for the management of the post office in this island, will expire on the thirty-first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven: Be it enacted by the governor of Jamaica, with the advice and consent of the legislative council thereof, as follows: Preamble.

The said act of the twenty-sixth Victoria, session one, chapter seven, is hereby continued in force from the said thirty-first day of March, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven, until the thirty-first day of December of the same year. Continued to 31st of December, 1867.
