Letters, &c., received from Places Over-Sea will also be forwarded for delivery.

II. FROM THE CAYMAN ISLAND.
Letters, &c. originating in the Cayman Islands and intended either for delivery in Jamaica, or for transmission to any place Over-Sea will be treated by the Jamaica Post-Office as though they had originated in Jamaica.
