THE GOVERNOR has approved of the following Rule in substitution of Rule 18 of the Regulations relating to the issue and payment of Postal

Orders within Jamaica, which were published in the Gazette of the 27th March, 1890.

RULE 18.--Where a Postal Order is crossed generally, the Paying Officer may pay it to any responsible person known to him, as well as through a banker.
