UNDER the Telephone Laws, 10 of 1893 and 19 of 1894, the Major General Administering the Government, in Privy Council, has granted to Samuel Sharp Wortley, Esquire, a Telephone License, to be in force till the 21st August, 1898, inclusive, within that part of the town of St. Jago de la Vega, or Spanish Town, which is contained within the following boundaries:—From the junction of Barrett Street and Burke Road with the Main Road leading to Kingston, following the northern side of Barrett Street, in a westerly direction, to Monk Street, thence along the eastern side of Monk Street, in a northerly direction to Market Street, thence along the northern side of Market Street to King Street, following the east side of Market Street, in a northerly direction, to Kent Street, thence on the northern side of Kent Street, to the Water Works reservoir, then along the eastern, southern and western sides of the said reservoir to the junction of Martin Street and Brunswick Street, thence along the northern side of Brunswick Street to the junction of the Main Road to Linstead with Cumberland Road, thence along the western side of Cumberland Road to William Street, then along the northern side of William Street, in a westerly direction, to the junction of Princess Street, and road from St. Johns, thence along the westerly side of Princess Street to junction of Manchester Street and Wellington Street, thence along the southern side of Wellington Street to junction of Rum Lane and Parochial Road to Salt Island, thence following the said Parochial Road to the Jamaica Railway, at the Goods Station thereof, thence along the southern side of the said railway, easterly to the road leading to March's Pen, following the eastern side of this

road in a northerly direction to Burke Road, and thence along the southern side of Burke Road, to its junction with Barrett Street, to the point started from.

THE MAJOR GENERAL ADMINISTERING THE GOVERNMENT directs the publication, for general information, of the following notice, under the provisions of Section 11 of the Jamaica Railway Company's Law, 12 of 1889.

I, Major General H. Jardine Hallows, Administering the Government of Jamaica and of its Dependencies, do hereby give notice that:

WHEREAS the West India Improvement Company, the "Promoters" of the Railway Extensions under the Jamaica Railway Company's Law, 1889, have constructed two further lengths of railway, namely, one length of 11.78 miles between Porus and Montego Bay, that is to say, from Ipswich Station to Cambridge Station, and another length of six miles from Bog Walk to a point six miles towards Port Antonio:

And Whereas the Government Inspector has examined the said sections and has reported the same completed within the provisions of the said Law and the agreement annexed thereto:

And Whereas the Jamaica Railway Company have paid for the said sections out of proceeds of Bonds at the rate of £8,000 per mile, and by an equal amount of ordinary stock of the Company in accordance with Article 17 of the said Agreement leaving the further or deferred payment to be made hereafter in accordance with Article 18 of the Agreement:

And Whereas the said section of railway is constructed in and upon those several parcels of land mentioned and referred to in the Schedules A. and B. hereunto, which have been acquired from time to time for the purpose of the said sections and which are represented on plans from time to time delivered to the said Promoters through the Surveyor General and signed by him, and which are now enclosed generally within fences:

I do hereby under and pursuant to the provisions

of the Jamaica Railway Company's Law declare that the said sections and lands and the equipment provided for the said sections have become vested in the Jamaica Railway Company, its successors and assigns:

And Whereas it appears that the five parcels of land mentioned in Schedule C. hereto, have been acquired for the railway extension to Montego Bay, and form part of the sections of railway which have been paid for by the Railway Company, but that the said lands have not been included in any schedule of lands vested in the said Railway Company: Now, therefore, I do hereby declare that the said five parcels of land mentioned in the said Schedule C. have become vested in the Jamaica Railway Company, its successors and assigns.
