JAMAICA Law No. 1. – 1923

A LAW to continue various expiring Laws.

BE it enacted by the Governor and Legislative Council of Jamaica as follows:-

1. This Law may be cited as the Expiring Laws Short title Continuance Law, 1923.

Short Title

2. The Laws mentioned in the Schedule to this Law shall be continued until and including the thirty-first day of March nineteen hundred and twenty-four.

- 1. The Post Office (War Tax) Law, 1919 (Law 7 of 1919)
- 2. The Package Tax (Temporary) Law, 1919 (Law 9 of 1919.)
- 3. The Excise Duties (Temporary Increase) Law, 1920 (Law 9 of 1920).
