A LAW to continue various expiring Laws.

BE it enacted by the Governor and Legislative Council of Jamaica as follows:-

SCHEDULE.

1. The Post Office (War Tax) Law, 1919 (Law 7 of 1919)
2. The Package Tax (Temporary) Law, 1919 (Law 9 of 1919.)
3. The Excise Duties (Temporary Increase) Law, 1920 (Law 9 of 1920) with the exception of the last item in the Schedule of the said Law which imposes a surtax of ten per cent on amounts payable as King's Warehouse fees.
