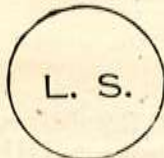

A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by a Proclamation dated the 20th day of May, 1942, and published in the Jamaica Gazette Supplement (Proclamations, Rules and Regulations) of the 21st day of May, 1942, the Head Polling Station and the District Polling Stations for the Electoral District of Saint Ann constituted under the Order in Council of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, dated the 3rd day of October, 1895, were appointed and fixed:

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to appoint and fix additional places to be district Polling Stations for the said Electoral District of Saint Ann:

NOW, THEREFORE, I the Governor in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 4 of "The Legislative Council Elections Law", Cap. 8 of the Revised Laws of Jamaica, do hereby ORDER AND PROCLAIM that the undermentioned places shall be and are hereby appointed and fixed to be District Polling Stations for the Electoral District of Saint Ann constituted by the said Order in Council.

(LAW 60 OF 1941)

REGULATIONS

(under Section 7 of the above Law)

THE POST OFFICE (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1942.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Post Office (Amendment) Regulations, 1942, and shall be read and construed as one with the Post Office Regulations, 1941, (hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations).

2. Regulations 12, 13, 34, 44, 75 and 155 of the principal Regulations are hereby rescinded.

3. Paragraph (a) of Sub-regulation (1) of Regulation 22 of the principal Regulations is hereby rescinded and the following paragraph substituted therefor:—

(a) consist of articles containing books or papers impressed or intended to be impressed in "Braille" or other special type or any articles specially adapted for the use of the blind and shall not contain any communication either in writing or printed in ordinary type except the title, date of publication, serial number, names and addresses of the manufacturer, printer or

publisher, price and table of contents of the articles and any key to, or instructions for, the use of the special type, or any enclosure except a label for the return of the articles.

4. Sub-regulation (3) of Regulation 24 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion of the words, "these Regulations", from the first line thereof and by the substitution thereof of the words, "an order under the Post Office Law, 1941".

5. These Regulations shall come into force and have effect as and from the fourth day of June, 1942.

(under Section 7 of the above Law)

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by Section 7 of the above Law, I, the Postmaster General hereby ORDER that the Rates of Postage shall be as set out in the Schedules hereto and shall take effect as and from the fourth day of June, 1942.

- (a) British Empire Each single one penny. Reply paid two pence.
- (b) Foreign Each single two pence. Reply paid four pence.
- (III) Small Packets addressed to any country or place with which the Postmaster General may for the time being have an arrangement for the exchange of "Small Packets". For the first ten ounces five pence and for every additional two ounces or fractional part thereof one penny.
- (IV) Printed Papers For every two ounces or fractional part thereof half-penny.
- (V) Commercial Papers For the first twelve ounces three pence and for each additional two ounces or fractional part thereof half-penny.
- (VI) Sample Articles For the first four ounces one penny and for each additional two ounces or fractional part thereof half-penny.
- (VII) Registration Fee Three pence.
- (VIII) Advice of Delivery (applied for at time of posting). Two pence (for registered or insured articles only.)
- (IX) Inquiry for and advice of delivery (applied for after posting). Four pence (for registered or insured articles only.)
- (X) Blind Literature For the first two pounds half-penny. Up to five pounds one penny. Up to eight pounds penny-half-penny. Up to eleven pounds two pence. Up to fifteen pounds (the maximum weight) two pence half-penny.
