With reference to Government Notice No. 33, published in the Jamaica Gazette of the 28th of May, 1942, the Governor in Privy Council on the 9th of September, 1943, under Section 7 of the Post Office Law, 1941, Law 60 of 1941, made the Post Office (Rates of Postage) (Amendment) Order, 1943, as set out:—

THE POST OFFICE LAW, 1941

(Law 60 of 1941)

THE POST OFFICE (RATES OF POSTAGE) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1943

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Privy Council by section 7 of the Post Office Law, 1941, the following Order made on the 20th day of July, 1943, by the Postmaster General under section 7 of the said Law is hereby approved:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Rates of Postage) (Amendment) Order, 1943, and shall be read and construed as one with the Order made under the Post Office Law, 1941, and published at page 245 of the Jamaica Gazette of the 28th day of May, 1942, (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order) and all amendments thereto.
2. This Order shall come into force on the 15th day of September, 1943.
3. The principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion of the word "Schedules" in the third line and the substitution therefor of the word "Schedule".
4. Item (XI) of the Schedule to the principal Order is hereby rescinded and the following item substituted therefor:—
