The Governor in Privy Council on the 8th of January, 1945, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 7 of the Post Office Law approved the Post Office (British West Indies Special Rate of Postage) Order, 1944, as set out:—

THE POST OFFICE LAW 1941**THE POST OFFICE (BRITISH WEST INDIES SPECIAL RATE OF POSTAGE) ORDER, 1944**

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Governor in Privy Council by section 7 of the Post Office Law, 1941, the following Order made on the 27th day of December, 1944, by the Acting Postmaster General under section 7 of the above Law is hereby approved:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (British West Indies Special Rate of Postage) Order, 1944, and shall come into force on the eighteenth day of January, 1945.
2. The Rate to be paid on air mail articles addressed to any British West Indian Island shall be Two Pence Half Penny for every half ounce.
3. The Rate herein provided shall apply to articles to be carried by aircraft of the British West Indian Airways Limited.

THE POST OFFICE LAW

(Law 60 of 1941)

THE POST OFFICE (BRITISH WEST INDIES SPECIAL RATE OF POSTAGE) ORDER, 1944

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (British West Indies Special Rate of Postage) Order, 1944, and shall come into force on the eighteenth day of January, 1945.
2. The Rate to be paid on air mail articles addressed to any British West Indian Island shall be Two Pence Half Penny for every half ounce.
3. The Rate herein provided shall apply to articles to be carried by aircraft of the British West Indian Airways Limited.
