THE CUSTOMS (FORMS) ORDER, 1944

In exercise of the power conferred upon me by section 255 of the Customs Law, 1939, I the Collector General hereby make the following Order—

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs (Forms) Order, 1944.
2. The form set out in the Schedule hereto is hereby prescribed for the purposes of the Customs Law, 1939.

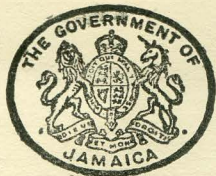
