THE POST OFFICE (LIGHT WEIGHT AIR MAIL) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1945

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Governor in Executive Council by section 7 of the Post Office Law, 1941, the following Order made on the 13th day of November, 1945, by the Postmaster General under section 7 of the said Law is hereby approved:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Light Weight Air Mail) (Amendment) Order, 1945, and shall be read and construed as one with the Post Office (Light Weight Air Mail) Order, 1944, (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order) and all amendments thereto.

2. Paragraph 2 of the principal Order is hereby rescinded and the following paragraph substituted therefor:—

“The rate to be paid on air letters weighing not more than one-tenth of an ounce shall be:—

- (1) Six pence for every letter addressed to the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, Eire or to any place within the British Empire in the Western Hemisphere;
- (2) One shilling and six pence for every letter addressed to any place within the British Empire in the Eastern Hemisphere and to Egypt, Iran and Iraq.”

3. This Order shall come into force on the 17th day of December, 1945.

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Rates of Postage) (Amendment) Order, 1945, and shall be read and construed as one with the Order made under the Post Office Law, 1941, and published at page 245 of the Jamaica Gazette of the 28th day of May, 1942, (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order) and all amendments thereto.

2. This Order shall come into force on the 16th day of December, 1945.

3. Item (XI) of the Schedule to the principal Order (inserted therein by the Post Office (Rates of Postage) (Amendment) Order, 1943) is hereby rescinded and the following item substituted therefor:—
