The Governor in Executive Council on the 30th of May, 1947, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 7 of the Post Office Law, 1941, approved the Post Office (Light Weight Air Mail) (Amendment) Order, 1947, as set out:—

THE POST OFFICE LAW, 1941
(Law 60 of 1941)

THE POST OFFICE (LIGHT WEIGHT AIR MAIL) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1947

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Executive Council by section 7 of the Post Office Law, 1941, the following Order made on the 10th day of May, 1947, by the Postmaster General under section 7 of the said Law is hereby approved:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Light Weight Air Mail) (Amendment) Order, 1947, and shall be read and construed as one with the Post Office (Light Weight Air Mail) Order, 1944, (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order) and all amendments thereto.
2. Paragraph 2 of the principal Order (inserted therein by the Post Office (Light Weight Air Mail) (Amendment) Order, 1945,) is hereby amended by the deletion from the first line of sub-paragraph 2 thereof of the words "One shilling and six pence" and the substitution therefor of the words "Nine pence."
3. This Order shall come into force on the 16th day of June, 1947.

THE POST OFFICE LAW, 1941
(Law 60 of 1941)

THE POST OFFICE (RATES OF POSTAGE) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1947

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Executive Council by section 7 of the Post Office Law, 1941, the following Order made on the 10th day of May, 1947, by the Postmaster General under section 7 of the said Law is hereby approved:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Rates of Postage) (Amendment) Order, 1947, and shall be read and construed as one with the Order made under the Post Office Law, 1941, and published at page 245 of the Jamaica Gazette of the 28th day of May, 1942, (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order) and all amendments thereto.
2. This Order shall come into force on the 16th day of June, 1947.
3. Item (XI) of the Schedule to the principal Order (inserted therein by the Post Office (Rates of Postage) (Amendment) Order, 1945) is hereby rescinded and the following item substituted therefor:-
