## THE TELEGRAPH LAW

(Cap. 246)

THE SOCIAL GREETING TELEGRAMS (PROHIBITION) ORDER, 1947

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by Rule 1 AB of the Telegraph Rules, 1933 (as inserted therein by the Telegraph (Amendment) Rules, 1943), I do hereby make the following Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Social Greeting Telegrams (Prohibited) Order, 1947.
- 2. No person shall send any inland social greeting telegram between the 18th day of December, 1947, and the 3rd day of January, 1948.
- 3. In this Order "Social greeting telegram" means any telegram containing any greetings, congratulations, or good wishes.
