With reference to Government Notice No. 4, published in the Jamaica Gazette Supplement, Proclamations, Rules and Regulations of the 17th of January, 1950, the Acting Governor in Executive Council on the 5th of February, 1951, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 7 of the Post Office Law, 1941, Law 60 of 1941, approved the Post Office (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 1950, made by the Postmaster General on the 25th of November, 1950, as set out:

THE POST OFFICE LAW, 1941

(Law 60 of 1941)

THE POST OFFICE (AMENDMENT) (No. 2) REGULATIONS, 1950

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Executive Council by section 7 of the Post Office Law, 1941, the following Regulations made on the 25th day of November, 1950, by the Postmaster General under section 7 of the said Law are hereby approved:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Post Office (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 1950, and shall be read and construed as one with the Post Office Regulations, 1941 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations), and all amendments thereto.

2. Regulation 80 (a) of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion of the words "received from or addressed to a place overseas" between the word "article" and the word "be" in the second line of this regulation and by the deletion of the sign and figure "£2" in the last line of this regulation and the substitution thereof of the sign and figures "£2. 18/-".

3. Regulation 80 (b) of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the insertion of the words "received from and addressed to a person in the island" between the word "article" and the word "be" in the first line of this regulation.

4. Regulation 82 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion of the words commencing with the word "shall" in the ninth line of the said regulation and ending with the word "weight" in the twelfth line of the said regulation and the substitution therefor of the following words and figures: "shall not be in excess of the amounts set out hereunder:—

"in respect of a parcel not exceeding 3 lbs. in weight	...	£1 3/-
not exceeding 7 lbs.	...	£1 15/-
not exceeding 11 lbs.	...	£2 18/-
and up to 22 lbs.	...	£4 13/-

5. The contents of the Sixth Schedule to the principal Regulations are hereby deleted and the following substituted therefor:—
