THE SOCIAL GREETING TELEGRAM (PROHIBITION) ORDER 1952

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by rule 1 as of the Telegraph Rules, 1933, (as inserted therein by the Telegraph (Amendment) Rules, 1943), I do hereby make the following order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Social Greeting Telegrams (Prohibition) Order, 1952.
- 2. No person shall send any inland social greeting telegram between the 17th day of December, 1952, and the 5th day of January, 1953.
- 3. In this Order "Social Greeting Telegram" means any telegram containing any greetings, congratulations, or good wishes.
