**THE POST OFFICE (RATES OF POSTAGE) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1956**

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Governor in Council by subsection 2 of section 7 of the Post Office Law, the following Order made on the 25th day of February, 1956, by the Postmaster General under the said subsection 2 of section 7 of the Post Office Law is hereby approved:—

“ **THE POST OFFICE (RATES OF POSTAGE) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1956**

In exercise of the powers conferred by the Postmaster General by subsection 2 of section 7 of the Post Office Law, the following Order is hereby made:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Rates of Postage) (Amendment) Order, 1956, and shall be read and construed as one with the Order made by the Postmaster General under the Post Office Law, 1941 and published in the Jamaica Gazette Supplement of the 28th day of May, 1942, at pages 245 to 255 inclusive (hereinafter referred to as ‘the principal Order’) and all amendments thereto.

2. This Order shall come into force on the 1st day of April, 1956.

3. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the following entry under the heading ‘(XII) Overseas Parcel Rates’:—

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'United States of America—8d. per lb. Limit 22 lb.'  
and the substitution therefor of the following:—

'United States of America—1/2. per lb. (Limit 22 lb.)'
