THE POST OFFICE (RATES OF POSTAGE) (AMENDMENT) (No. 4) ORDER, 1956

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Executive Council by section 7 of the Post Office Law, the following Order made on the tenth day of May, 1956, by the Postmaster General under subsection (2) of the said section 7 of the Post Office Law is hereby approved:—

THE POST OFFICE (RATES OF POSTAGE) (AMENDMENT) (No. 4) ORDER, 1956

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Postmaster General under subsection (2) of section 7 of the Post Office Law, the following Order is hereby made:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Rates of Postage) (Amendment) (No. 4) Order, 1956, and shall be read and construed as one with the Order made by the Postmaster General under the Post Office Law, 1941, and published in the Jamaica Gazette Supplement of the 28th day of May, 1942, at pages 245 to 255 inclusive (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order) and all amendments thereto.

2. This Order shall come into force on the 1st day of June, 1956, but the rates provided herein in respect of Canada and the United States of America shall not come into effect until the 1st day of July, 1956.

3. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended under the heading "Schedule of Air Mail Rates" as follows:—

(a) By adding after the column headed "Newspapers Rate per $\frac{1}{2}$ oz." a column headed "Parcels per $\frac{1}{2}$ lb" with the rates set out on the right hereunder each such rate to correspond with the destination appearing opposite thereto on the left hereunder:—
