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## THE POST OFFICE LAW

(Cap. 301)

THE POST OFFICE (RATES OF POSTAGE) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1959

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by subsection (2) of section 7 of the Post Office Law, the following Order made on the twentieth day of February, 1959, by the Postmaster General under the said subsection (2) of section 7 of the Post Office Law is hereby approved:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Rates of Postage) (Amendment) Order, 1959, and shall be read and construed as one with the Order made by the Postmaster General under the Post Office Law and published in the Jamaica Gazette Supplement of the 28th day of May, 1942, at pages 245 to 255 inclusive (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order) and all amendments thereto.
  - 2. This Order shall come into force on the 1st day of April, 1959.

3. The Schedule to the principal Order as amended by the Post Office (Rates of Postage) (Amendment) Order, 1950, is hereby amended by deleting therefrom all entries relating to items (I), (II), (III), (IV), (V) and (X) under the heading "Overseas" and substituting therefor the following:—

	(b) Foreign	Single Reply-paid	4d. 8d.
(III)	Printed Papers	Not exceeding 2 oz For each additional 2 oz.	2d. 1d.
(1V)	Commercial Papers	Not exceeding 10 oz For each additional 2 oz.	6d. 1d
(V)	Samples	Not exceeding 2 oz For each additional 2 oz	2d. 1d.
(X)	Small Packets	Not exceeding 10 oz For each additional 2 oz.	10d. 2d."
