THE POST OFFICE (RATES OF POSTAGE) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1960

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Postmaster General under subsection (2) of section 7 of the Post Office Law, the following Order is hereby made:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Rates of Postage) (Amendment) Order, 1960, and shall be read and construed as one with the Order made by the Postmaster General under the Post Office Law, 1941, and published in the Jamaica Gazette Supplement of the 28th day of May, 1942, at pages 245 to 255 inclusive (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order) and all amendments thereto.

2. This Order shall come into force on the first day of February, 1960.

3. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended under the heading "Schedule of Air Mail Rates" by adding to the column headed "Parcels per $\frac{1}{2}$ lb." the rates set out on the right hereunder each such rate to correspond with the destination appearing opposite thereto on the left hereunder:—
