THE POST OFFICE (RATES OF POSTAGE) (AMENDMENT) (No. 2) ORDER, 1960

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Governor in Council by section 7 of the Post Office Law and by virtue of section 9 of the Jamaica (Constitution) Order in Council, 1959, the following Order made on the 29th day of September, 1960, by the Postmaster General under subsection (2) of the said section 7 of the Post Office Law is hereby approved:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Rates of Postage) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 1960, and shall be read and construed as one with the Order made by the Postmaster General under the Post Office Law, 1941, and published in the Jamaica Gazette Supplement of the 28th day of May, 1942, at pages 245 and 255 inclusive (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order) and all amendments thereto.

2. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended under the heading

"Schedule of Air Mail Rates", as follows-

(a) by the deletion of the rates relating to Hawaii and Puerto Rico and the substitution therefor of the rate specified in the First Schedule to this Order respectively; and

(b) by the addition of the rates specified in the Second Schedule to this

Order.

3. This Order shall come into force on the first day of November, 1960.
