THE POST OFFICE (RATES OF POSTAGE) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1961.

The Postmaster-General with the approval of the Minister of Communications and Works, in exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (2) of section 7 of the Post Office Law and of every other power hereunto enabling, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Rates of Postage) (Amendment) Order, 1961, and shall be read and construed as one with the Order made by the Postmaster-General under the Post Office Law and published in the Jamaica Gazette Supplement of the 28th day of May, 1942, at pages 245 to 255 inclusive (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order) and all amendments thereto.

2 The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended under the heading "Air Mail Rates" by deleting the rates relating to the Cayman Islands and substituting therefor the rates specified in the Schedule hereto.

3. This Order shall come into force on the 10th day of August, 1961.
