Notice is hereby given that a certified copy of the Royal Warrant dated 13th July, 1962, authorising the recent change of Motto in the Coat of Arms of Jamaica has been deposited in the Government Archives, Spanish Town. The text of the Warrant, together with the official depiction of the Coat of Arms is reproduced below:

**Elizabeth the Second** by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and of Our other Realms and Territories **Queen**, Head of the Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith, to Our Right Trusty and Right Entirely Beloved Cousin and Counsellor, Bernard Marmaduke, Duke of Norfolk, Knight of Our Most Noble Order of the Garter, Knight Grand Cross of Our Royal Victorian Order, Earl Marshal and Our Hereditary Marshal of England, Greeting!

**Whereas** We by Warrant under Our Royal Sign Manual dated the Eighth day of April, 1957, in the Sixth year of Our Reign, did grant confirm and assign certain Armorial Ensigns and Supporters together with a Motto, to be borne and used for Our Territory of Jamaica.

**And whereas** it hath been represented unto Us that Our Trusty and Well Beloved Ministers and Legislature of Our said Territory of Jamaica are desirous of changing the Motto then granted and assigned.

**Know ye therefore** that We of Our Princely Grace and Special Favour do hereby annul the said Motto and do substitute for it this Motto, **OUT OF MANY, ONE PEOPLE** as the same is in the painting herunto annexed more plainly depicted to be borne and used as amply and as fully as that hitherto granted and assigned.

Our Will and Pleasure therefore is that you the said Bernard Marmaduke, Duke of Norfolk to whom the cognizance of matters of this nature doth properly belong, do require and command that this Our Concession and Declaration be recorded in Our College of Arms to the end that Our Officers of Arms and all other Public
