THE POST OFFICE LAW
(Cap. 301)

THE POST OFFICE (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1966

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Postmaster General by subsection (1) of section 7 of the Post Office Law, the following Regulations are hereby made with the approval of the Minister:—

1. This Regulation may be cited as the Post Office (Amendment) Regulations, 1966, and shall be read and construed as one with the Post Office Regulations, 1941 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations) and all amendments thereto and shall come into operation on the 5th day of May, 1966.

2. Regulation 71 of the principal Regulations is hereby revoked and the following substituted therefor—

“71—In addition to any sum in respect of postage, customs duty, or otherwise, there shall be charged on every postal article received from abroad upon which customs duty is levied, a clearance fee of one shilling.”
