### A BILL

ENTITLED

AN ACT to Amend the Post Office Law.

[ ]

BE IT ENACTED by The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Representatives of Jamaica, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

- 5     1—This Act may be cited as the Post Office (Amendment) Act, 1966, and shall be read and construed as one with the Post Office Law (hereinafter referred to as the principal Law) and all amendments thereto, and shall come into operation on the commencement of the Stamp Duty (Amendment) Act, 1966.

2—Subsection (1) of section 13 of the principal Law is hereby amended by deleting the words "Commissioner of Stamps" and substituting therefor the words "Postmaster General".
