THE POST OFFICE (RATES OF POSTAGE) (AMENDMENT) (NO. 2) ORDER, 1967

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Postmaster General by subsection (2) of section 7 of the Post Office Law, the following Order is hereby made with the approval of the Minister:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Rates of Postage) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 1967, and shall be read and construed as one with the Order made under the Post Office Law, 1941, and published in the Jamaica Gazette Supplement of the 28th May, 1942, at pages 245 to 255 inclusive (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order) and all amendments thereto, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of April, 1967.

2. The Schedule to the Principal Order is hereby amended by deleting from item (X) (Small Packets) the figures "1/3d." and substituting therefor the figure "1/-".
