THE POST OFFICE (RATES OF POSTAGE) (AMENDMENT) (NO. 3) ORDER, 1967

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Postmaster General by subsection (2) of section 7 of the Post Office Law, the following Order is hereby made with the approval of the Minister:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Rates of Postage) (Amendment) (No. 3) Order, 1967, and shall be read and construed as one with the Order made under the Post Office Law, 1941 and published in the Jamaica Gazette Supplement of the 28th May, 1942 at pages 245 to 255 inclusive (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order) and all amendments thereto, and shall come into operation on the first day of November, 1967.

2. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by deleting the figure "8d" from under the column headed "Letters Rate per $\frac{1}{2}$ oz" appearing opposite the words "Hawaii" and "Puerto Rico" and "Alaska" and substituting therefor, respectively, the figure "1/-".
