THE POST OFFICE LAW
(Cap. 301)

The Post Office (Rates of Postage) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 1968.

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Postmaster General by subsection (2) of section 7 of the Post Office Law, the following Order is hereby made with the approval of the Minister:—

This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Rates of Postage) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 1968, and shall be read and construed as one with the Order made under the Post Office Law, 1941 and published in the Jamaica Gazette Supplement of the 28th May, 1942 at pages 245 to 255 inclusive (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order) and all amendments thereto.

This Order shall come into force on the 1st day of July, 1968. 3. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended in the following respects:—

- (a) by deleting from under the heading "Inland Postage" where it relates to "Printed papers", the words "one penny half penny" and substituting therefor the word "twopence";
- (b) by deleting all the words, figures and symbols from the column headed "Registration Fee" and substituting therefor the following:—
"Not exceeding £10 compensation of a fee of ninepence and an additional sum of twopence in respect of every additional £10 limit of compensation up to maximum limit of compensation of £400".;
- (c) by deleting from the entry relating to item "(I) Letters" the figures and letters "6d." and "4d." and substituting therefor the figures and letters "9d." and "5d.", respectively;
- (d) by deleting from the entry relating to item "(II) Postcards" under the heading "Overseas", the figures and letters "2½d.", "5d.", "4d." and "8d." and substituting therefor the figures and letters "3d.", "6d.", "5d." and "10d.", respectively;
- (e) by deleting from the entry relating to item "(III) Printed Papers" under the heading "Overseas" the figures and letters "3d." and "1½d." and substituting therefor the figures and letters "4d." and "2d.", respectively;
- (f) by deleting from the entry relating to the item "(V) Samples" the figures and letters "2oz 6d." and "1½d." and substituting therefor the figures and letters "6oz 9d." and "2d.", respectively;
- (g) by deleting from the entry relating to the item "(X) Small Packets" under the heading "Overseas" the figures, symbol and letter "1/-" and "3d." and substituting therefor the figures, symbol and letter "1/6" and "4d.", respectively;
- (h) by deleting therefrom all the Air Mail Rates and substituting therefor the rates specified in the Schedule to this Order.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Post Office (Amendment) Regulations, 1968, and shall be read and construed as one with the Post Office Regulations, 1941 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations) and all amendments thereto.
2. These Regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of July, 1968.
3. Regulation 71 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by inserting immediately after the words "one shilling" the words "and sixpence".
4. Paragraph (1) of regulation 76 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by deleting therefrom the words "twopence" and "fourpence" and substituting therefor the words "fourpence" and "sixpence", respectively.
5. Paragraph (a) of regulation 77 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by inserting immediately after the words "one shilling" the words "and sixpence".

(a) Paragraph 3(b)

Delete the word "therefrom" and substitute therefor the words "from the Overseas Parcels Rates";

(b) Second Schedule

Insert immediately after the word "Bechuanaland" the word "Protectorate";

Delete from the first column the words "Naura Islands" and substitute therefor the words "Maura Islands";

(iii) Insert immediately after the words "North Borneo" the brackets and words "(Including Labaun)".

New postal rates effective July 1

The Post Office Law has been amended to allow for changes in the rates of postage. The amending Act was published in the Jamaica Gazette Supplement Friday, June 21, and the new rates become effective next Monday, July 1. The Postmaster General has already, Issued information circulars to all head postmasters, senior regional Inspectors, regional inspectors, postmasters and postal agents in preparation for Monday's change of rates. The information is reproduced below:

Whereas the postage on a one ounce letter to a foreign country by surface mail was 6d it will now be 9d. Each additional ounce will be increased from 4d to 5d.

The postage on a surface postcard to a Commonwealth country has been increased from 2½d to 3d. The postage on a surface postcard to a Foreign country has been increased from 4d to 5d. The postage on Printed Papers by surface mail to all overseas destinations has been increased from 3d for the first 2 oz. to 4d, and from 1½d for each additional 2 oz to 2d. The postage on samples to all overseas destinations has been increased from 6d for the first 4 oz to 9d for the first 6oz and from 1½d for each additional 2 oz. to 4d.

- The postage on Small Packets by surface mail has been increased from 1/- for the first 10 oz. minimum to 1/6d and from 3d for each additional 2 oz. to 4d.
- Air Letter Forms to all destinations are now 9d including the pictorial air letter form. A 3d stamp must be affixed to the present embossed 6d, air Letter form before it is sold.

- The minimum registration fee on all items has been increased from 6d to 9d Accordingly the rate of compensation has been raised from £2 to £10

- The fee paid on an Advice of Delivery Card at the time of posting has been increased from 2d. to 4d. and the fee to be paid for enquiry after posting has been increased from 4d to 6d.

The airmail postage of 6d per ½ oz to those countries in South. Central America and Caribbean areas has been increased to 9d per ½ oz.

- The airmail postage of 6d. per ½ oz. to Commonwealth Caribbean areas; British Honduras and Guyana has been increased to 9d, per ½ oz.
- The airmail postage on postcards to certain countries those in Central America and South America, Bermuda and non - Commonwealth Caribbean territories — has been increased from 5d, to 6d. per ½ oz.
- The air mail postage on Second Class Matter to those same countries has been increased from 4d, to 6d. per ½ oz.
- The rate for printed papers in- the inland mail has been increased from 1½d for the first 2 oz. to 2d. for the first 2 oz. There is no change in the charge for the additional ounce or part thereof.
- The charge for Customs Clearance Fee has been increased from 1/- to 1/6d.

Effective last month, on June 1: The parcel post rate to the Bahamas by surface mail was increased. The charge for the first 12 words on inland telegrams was increased from 2/- to 2/6d: and on the first 12 words for priority telegrams from 2/9d. to 3/3d, There was no change in the charge for each additional word.
