1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Rates of Postage) (Her Majesty's Forces) Order, 1968.

2. In this Order—

“authorized officer” means any person authorized by the Chief of Staff of the Jamaica Defence Force to collect mails addressed to members of British Forces overseas and thereafter deliver such mails to the Postmaster-General;

“British Forces overseas” means any naval, military or air forces raised in any territory within the Commonwealth by Her Majesty or the Government of such territory and such forces are serving in a country other than Jamaica;

“Her Majesty's Forces” means any of the naval, military or air forces raised in the United Kingdom by Her Majesty.

3. The rates of postage to be paid by members of Her Majesty's Forces serving in Jamaica in respect of mails addressed to members of British Forces overseas, shall be as specified in the Schedule.

4. The provisions of paragraph 3 shall apply only if the mails are delivered to the Postmaster-General by an authorized officer of the Jamaica Defence Force.
