THE POST OFFICE LAW
(Cap. 301)

THE POST OFFICE (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1969

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Postmaster General by Section 7 of the Post Office Law, the following Regulations are hereby made with the approval of the Minister:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Post Office (Amendment) Regulations, 1969 and shall be read and construed as one with the Post Office Regulations, 1941 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations) and all amendments thereto.
2. Regulation 74 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended in the following respects—
 - (a) by deleting from paragraph (1) thereof the word “sixpence” and substituting therefor the word “ninepence”;
 - (b) by deleting from paragraph (2) thereof the symbol and figure “£2” and substituting therefor the symbol and figures “£10”; and

(c) by deleting paragraph (3) and substituting therefor the following—

“ (3) An additional sum of twopence shall be charged and paid on every such postal article in respect of each additional £10 limit of compensation which the sender desires to be payable up to a maximum limit of compensation of £400.”

3. Regulation 80 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended in the following respects—

- (a) by deleting from paragraph (a) thereof the symbols and figures “£2 18/-” and substituting therefor the symbols and figures “£3 8/-”; and
- (b) by deleting from paragraph (b) thereof the symbol and figure “£2” and substituting therefor the symbol and figures “£10”.

4. Regulation 82 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by deleting therefrom the following—

“in respect of a parcel not exceeding 3lb in weight ...	£1	3	0
not exceeding 7lb	£1	15	0
not exceeding 11lb	£2	18	0
and up to 22lb	£4	13	0”

and substituting therefor the following—

“in respect of a parcel not exceeding 3lb in weight ...	£1	7	0
in respect of a parcel not exceeding 7lb in weight ...	£2	1	0
in respect of a parcel not exceeding 11lb in weight	£3	8	0
in respect of a parcel up to 22lb in weight ...	£5	9	0”
