THE POST OFFICE LAW
(Cap. 301)

THE POST OFFICE (LIGHT WEIGHT AIR MAIL) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1969

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Postmaster-General by section 7 of the Post Office Law, and with the approval of the Minister, the following Order is hereby made:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Light Weight Air Mail) (Amendment) Order, 1969, and shall be read and construed as one with the Post Office (Light Weight Air Mail) Order, 1944 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order) and all amendments thereto.

2. The principal Order is hereby amended by deleting therefrom paragraph 2 and substituting the following as paragraph 2—

“2. The rate to be paid on air mail letters weighing not more than one-tenth of an ounce shall be as set forth in the Post Office (Postal Charges) Order, 1969, made by the Postmaster-General and approved by the Minister on the 5th day of September, 1969.”

THE POST OFFICE LAW
(Cap. 301)

THE POST OFFICE (POSTAL CHARGES) ORDER, 1969

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Postmaster-General by section 7 of the Post Office Law, and with the approval of the Minister, the following Order is hereby made:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Postal Charges) Order, 1969, and shall come into force on the 8th day of September, 1969.

2. The rates and charges specified in the First and Second Schedules hereto shall be the rates of postage for the classes of postal articles listed in the said Schedules, and the charges payable in respect of services provided by the Post Office.

3. From the date of the coming into force of this Order the following Orders are hereby revoked—

- (a) Order made under the Post Office Law, 1941, and published in the Jamaica Gazette Supplement of the 28th May, 1942, at pages 245 to 255 inclusive, and all amendments thereto;
- (b) The Post Office (Fee for Express Delivery) Order, 1957;
- (c) the Post Office (Fee for Business Reply Service) Order, 1959;
- (d) the Post Office (British Postal Orders) (Rates of Poundage) Order, 1966, and all amendments thereto;
- (e) the Post Office (Jamaica Postal Orders) (Rates of Poundage) Order, 1968, and all amendments thereto.

THE POST OFFICE LAW
(Cap. 301)

THE POST OFFICE (AMENDMENT) (No. 2) REGULATIONS, 1969

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Postmaster-General by section 7 of the Post Office Law, and with the approval of the Minister, the following Regulations are hereby made:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Post Office (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 1969, and shall be read and construed as one with the Post Office

Regulations, 1941 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations) and all amendments thereto.

2. These Regulations shall come into force on the 8th day of September, 1969.

3. Regulation 7 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended in the following respects—

- (a) by inserting a fullstop after the words “for sale to the public”; and
- (b) by deleting all the words from the words “at the following prices” to the end of the paragraph.

4. Regulation 55 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by deleting therefrom paragraph (1) and substituting therefor the following—

“(1) There shall be charged and paid on every incoming and outgoing cash on delivery parcel, in addition to the postage and any other charges payable, a cash on delivery fee and, on every outgoing parcel, a despatch fee.”.

5. Regulation 71 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended in the following respects—

- (a) by inserting between the words “a” and “clearance” the word “customs”;
- (b) by inserting a fullstop after the words “clearance fee”; and
- (c) by deleting the words “of one shilling and sixpence.”.

6. Regulation 74 of the principal Regulations is hereby revoked and the following substituted therefor—

“Compensation on registered article.

74. (1) There shall be charged and paid for the registration of every inland postal article a fee to ensure compensation in the event of loss, damage or destruction in the course of transmission by post of such registered article.

(2) The fee charged shall ensure compensation up to a limit of 20 dollars, and an additional sum shall be charged and paid in respect of each additional 20 dollars of compensation which the sender desires to be payable up to a maximum limit of compensation of 800 dollars.”.

7. Paragraph (1) of regulation 76 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended in the following respects—

- (a) by deleting from the second sentence of the paragraph the words “is fourpence, which”; and
- (b) by deleting from the third sentence of the paragraph the words “of sixpence”.

8. The proviso to regulation 83 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by deleting therefrom paragraph (a) and substituting therefor the following—

“(a) in the case of an outgoing insured letter where, in addition to the postage payable in respect of such letter and a registration fee at the prescribed rates, a compensation fee of 5 cents for each 28 dollars of value is paid, the sum payable shall not exceed the appropriate sum specified in the Sixth Schedule to these Regulations;”.

9. Regulation 90 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by deleting therefrom the symbol and figures "£12" and substituting therefor the symbol and figures "\$28".

10. Regulation 101 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended in the following respects—

- (a) by deleting paragraph (b);
- (b) by deleting from paragraph (c) the words "foregoing rates" and substituting therefor the words "annual rate"; and
- (c) by deleting from paragraph (f) the words "of two pounds".

11. Regulation 110 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended in the following respects—

- (a) by deleting from paragraph (1) the words "fees set out in paragraph (2) of this Regulation" and substituting therefor the words "prescribed fees";
- (b) by deleting paragraph (2) and substituting therefor the following—

"(2) The rent of a private letter bag shall be payable in advance in respect of each fiscal year, and, where a private letter bag is rented on or after the 1st of April in any year, the rent for the balance of that year shall be calculated at the rate of one-twelfth for each month or part of a month."

12. Regulation 115 of the principal Regulations is hereby revoked.

13. The Second Schedule to the principal Regulations is hereby revoked.

14. The Third Schedule to the principal Regulations is hereby revoked.

15. The Fourth Schedule to the principal Regulations is hereby revoked.

THE TELEGRAPH LAW
(Cap 377)

THE TELEGRAPH (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1969

In exercise of the power conferred upon the Postmaster-General by section 7 of the Telegraph Law, and with the approval of the Minister, the following Rules are hereby made:—

- 1. These Rules may be cited as the Telegraph (Amendment) Rules, 1969, and shall be read and construed as one with the Telegraph Rules, 1933 (hereinafter

referred to as the principal Rules) and all amendments thereto, and shall come into force on the 8th day of September, 1969.

2. Rule 1 of the principal Rules is hereby amended in the following respects—

- (a) by deleting from paragraph (1) the words “two shillings and sixpence” and “twopence” and substituting therefor “twenty-five cents” and “two cents” respectively;
- (b) by deleting from paragraph (2) the words “three shillings and threepence”, wherever these words occur, and “twopence” and substituting therefor the words “thirty-two cents” and “two cents” respectively;
- (c) by deleting from paragraph (3) the words “sixpence” wherever this word occurs, “halfpenny” and “two”, and substituting therefor the words “five cents”, “cent” and “four” respectively.

3. Rule 2 of the principal Rules is hereby amended in the following respects—

- (a) by deleting from the first sentence the word “penny” and substituting therefor the word “cent”; and
- (b) by deleting from the second sentence the word “penny” and substituting therefor the words “one cent”.

4. Rule 3 of the principal Rules is hereby amended by deleting the words “fractions of a half penny shall count as a half penny” and substituting therefor the words “fractions of a cent shall count as one cent”.

5. Rule 8 of the principal Rules is hereby amended by deleting from paragraph (e) the word “ninepence” and substituting therefor the words “eight cents”.

6. Rule 28 of the principal Rules is hereby amended by deleting the sentence “The cost for the above would be 3/2d viz: 13 words 2/2d plus 1/- postage,” and substituting therefor the following sentence—

“The cost for the above would be 37 cents viz: 13 words 27 cents plus 10 cents postage.”.

7. Rule 45 of the principal Rules is hereby amended in the following respects—

- (a) by deleting from paragraph (i) the words, symbols and figures from “7/6 shall count as one word” to “the symbol £ being counted as a word” and substituting therefor the following—

“ 1c or 99c shall count as one word.

\$125.75 or \$125— shall count as three words, the symbol
¹⁰⁰

\$ being counted as a word. However \$12346.75 shall count as three words, but

⁷⁵
\$12345— shall count as four words.
¹⁰⁰

\$1.75c shall count as three words but

- (b) by deleting from paragraph (k) all the words and figures from "7 pence count" to the end of the paragraph and substituting therefor the following—

"7 cents count as two words, 16 dollars and 8 cents as five words, 175.55 dollars as three words, 25 dollars 25c as three words. The words onecent, fivecent, tencent, halfdollar, may be accepted as one word if so written by the sender, but combinations such as fiftyninecent, onedollarten, etc., must be separated and counted as individual words (fiftynine cent, one dollar ten, etc.)."
