**THE POST OFFICE LAW**  
(Cap. 301)**THE POST OFFICE (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1972**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Postmaster-General by section 7 of the Post Office Law, and with the approval of the Minister, the following Regulations are hereby made:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Post Office (Amendment) Regulations, 1972 and shall be read and construed as one with the Post Office Regulations, 1941 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations) and all amendments thereto, and shall come into force on the 1st day of June, 1972.

2. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by deleting Regulation 154 thereof and substituting therefor the following—

“154. British postal orders, payable at all post offices in Jamaica, in the United Kingdom and such other countries as may be specified in the British Post Office Guide, shall be issued in Jamaica in the following denominations—

five new pence

ten new pence

fifteen new pence

twenty new pence

twenty-five new pence

forty new pence

fifty new pence

one pound

five pound.”

**THE POST OFFICE (POSTAL CHARGES) (AMENDMENT)  
ORDER, 1972**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Postmaster-General by section 7 of the Post Office Law, and with the approval of the Minister, the following Order is hereby made:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Postal Charges) (Amendment) Order, 1972 and shall be read and construed as one with the Post Office (Postal charges) Order, 1969 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order) and all amendments thereto, and shall come into force on the first day of June, 1972.

2. The First Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by deleting paragraph (b) of item 29 and substituting therefor the following—

“(b) British
