Local tirst class matl has e doubled and as of Monday it will cost 50 cents to mail a local letter.

The increases were announced by the Minister of Public Utilities and Transport, Hon Bobby Pickersgill through Jampress, the Governs ment news agency

The new rates are:

- Airmall to US and the Carlbbean, up from 55 cents to $\$ 1.10$.

Airmall to the United Kingdom and Europe, up from 70 cents to \$1.40; - Alrmall to the Far East, up from 90 cents to $\$ 1.80$;

- Local firstclass mail, up from 25 cents to 50 cents.
- Surface mail, 2 lb parcel to the United Kingdom up from \$13.95 to \$19.65;
- Surface mall, 2 lb parcel to the United States up from $\$ 5.45$ to \$14.05 The Minister said several improvements are being made to the postal system, among them the installation of a survelilance system at the Central Sorting Office to enhance security of mall there.

Mr . Pickersgill noted that the last increase was in 1984 and current rates had become unreallstic because of rising salaries, transportation, utillties and services by foreign postal administrations.
