
e Local Pirst class mail has doubled and as of Monday it will toost 50 cents to mail a local letter.

The increases were announced by the Minister of Public Utilities and Transport, Hon Bobby Pickersgill through Jampress, the Government news agency

The new rates are:

- Airmail to US and the Caribbean, up from 55 cents to \$1.10.
- Airmail to the United Kingdom and Europe, up from 70 cents to \$1.40; Airmail to the Far East, up from 90 cents to \$1.80;
- Local firstclass mail, up from 25 cents to 50 cents.
- Surface mail, 2 lb parcel to the United Kingdom up from \$13.95 to \$19.65;
- Surface mail, 2 ib parcel to the United States up from 95.45 to \$14.05 The Minister said several improvements are being made to the postal system, among them the installation of a surveillance system at the Central Sorting Office to enhance security of mail there.
- Mr. Pickersgill noted that the last increase was in 1984 and current rates had become unrealistic because of rising salaries, transportation, utilities and services by foreign postal administrations.
