The Public is hereby advised that International "Express Mail Service" (E.M.S.) will commence between the United Kingdom Postal Administration and the Jamaica Postal Administration on April 4, 1990.

The service will initially be restricted to deliveries of incoming mail only to the Kingston Metropolitan area.

Mail rates up Monday

POSTAL rates are to be increased on Monday including a hike of more than 100 per cent in the rental of letter boxes from \$30 to \$100

Local first class mail has doubled and as of Monday it will cost 50 cents to mail a local letter.

The increases were announced by the Minister of Public Utilities and Transport, Hon Bobby Pickersgill through Jampress, the Government news agency

The new rates are:

● Airmail to US and the Caribbean, up from 55 cents to \$1.10.

● Airmail to the United Kingdom and Europe, up from 70 cents to \$1.40; ● Airmail to the Far East, up from 90 cents to \$1.80;

● Local firstclass mail, up from 25 cents to 50 cents.

● Surface mail, 2 lb parcel to the United Kingdom up from \$13.95 to \$19.65;

● Surface mail, 2 lb parcel to the United States up from \$5.45 to \$14.05 The Minister said several improvements are being made to the postal system, among them the installation of a surveillance system at the Central Sorting Office to enhance security of mail there.

Mr. Pickersgill noted that the last increase was in 1984 and current rates had become unrealistic because of rising salaries, transportation, utilities and services by foreign postal administrations.
