## AIR MAIL SERVICES.

Southbound: A mail-carrying air plane flies from Miami, U.S.A. every Tuesday and Friday at 9 30 a.m., arrives at Kingston on the same days at 5 p.m., and flies to Cristobal on Wednesdays and Saturdays at 9 a.m., arriving on the same days at 2.45 p.m.

NORTHBOUND: A plane flies from Cristobal every Sunday and Wednesday at 8 a.m., arrives at Kingston on the same days at 3.45 p.m., and flies to Miami on Mordays and Thursdays at 8.30 a.m., arriving on the same days at 3.30 p.m.

Planes fly daily from Miami to all points in the United States. Letters for New York, N.Y. are due to reach that city at 9.30 a.m. on Tuesday and Friday mornings.

Planes fly daily (except Sundays) from Miami for Nassau and Canada and daily for Havana, Cuba.

The following connexions are scheduled for Mexico, Central and

South America and the West India Islands.

(a) Planes fly from Cristobal at 7.30 a.m. on Thursdays for Colombia (East Coast), Venezuela, Curacao and Trinidad; at 6 a.m. on Thursdays and Sundays for Colombia (West Coast), Ecuador, Peru Chile, Argentina, and Uruguay; and at 6.30 a.m. on Sundays and Wednesdays for Divid, R.P., Costa Rica, Nicaragua, Honduras (Republic, South Coast and Tegucigalpa), El Salvador, Guatemala, and Mexico.

(b) Planes fly from Miami at 2 p.m. on Mondays and Thursdays

for British Honduras, and Honduras (Republic, North Coast).\*

(c) Planes fly from Miami at 6 a.m. on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays for Haiti, Dominicana (Republic), and Porto Rico. From Porto Rico on Tuesdays (only) at 8.30 a.m. for Virgin Islands (U.S.A.), Antigua, St. Lucia, Trinidad, British and Dutch Guiana, and Brazil.

AIR MAIL FOR EUROPE AND AFRICA:-Letters mailed in time for dispatch on the Thursday plane should reach New York in time to connect with the fast steamers sailing on Saturdays, affording a 81 to 12-day service to the United Kingdom and the Continent depending upon the speed of the vessel by which forwarded. The same service is afforded letters forwarded by the Monday plane which connects with the fast steamers sailing from New York on Wednesdays.

The subjoined list shows the routes from London to the Continent which are now available for the dispatch of letters intended for dispatch by the above-mentioned air mail service.

Letters should be marked in the upper left-hand corner of the envelopes or covers, "Par Avion (by air mail) from London or Cher-

bourg. Letters for transmission by air to Delhi should also be marked at the top left-hand corner of the envelope "by air to Delhi."

AIR MAIL FOR AUSTRALASIA, ETC:-Letters for Australasia, China, Japan, etc. are forwarded by air to U.S. Pacific exchange post office for transmission by steamer to destination.

Special attention is directed to the fact that the unit of weight for Air Mail letters is the half ounce and not the ounce as for steamer mail.

Letters intended for transmission by air must be fully prepaid to the extent of the air fee. Thus: a letter weighing 1 oz. addressed to the United States, for which the correct postage is 1/1112  $(=1/7\frac{1}{2} \text{ air fee, plus 4d. regular postage}), if prepaid <math>1/7\frac{1}{2}$  would be surcharged 8d. or 16 cents and be forwarded by air mail, but if prepaid less than  $1/7\frac{1}{2}$  it would not be forwarded by air but by steamer.
