

Trans-Pacific Air Mail—There is a fortnightly air mail service (commenced Saturday, June 13, 1940) on the route from San Francisco by Honolulu, Canton Island (South Pacific), and Noumea (New Caledonia), to Auckland (New Zealand), with connecting air service between Auckland and Sydney. Mail closes at G.P.O., Kingston at 9.30 a.m. on alternate Tuesday arriving at Auckland on second Thursday.

The British air mail service has been resumed from Hong Kong via Siam, Malaya, and Netherlands Indies to Australia, connecting at Hong Kong with the weekly service between San Francisco and Hong Kong, (See above for closing time at G.P.O. for Hong Kong). Air mails for Australia will be routed via Auckland as well as via Hong Kong. Air mails for New Zealand will be routed via the direct service only. Air mails for Burma, Egypt, India, Indo-China, Kenya-Uganda, Madagascar, Nyasaland, Palestine, Rhodesia, (Northern and Southern), South Africa, Tanganyika, are forwarded over transpacific air route from San Francisco and Hong Kong (see above for closing time for Hong Kong).
