## INSURANCE

Available to certain countries for letters and parcels
Enquire at the Post Office.

4d. per Ib (limit 20 lb )

Repistration F'es (Lellers and Parcels)
(additional to normal postage)

6d. to cover compensation up to $£ 2$

9d. to cover compensation up to $£ 10$

2d. for each additional $£ 10$ cover: maximum $£ 400$.

Receipts for the posting of unregistered letters, packets and parcels are not issued.
